## Taiwan - Beyond the „Current Affairs“ Reporting

Currently two IJP reporters are based in Taiwan. They will share their insights on topics that often don't make it into the German media. What drives the young generation? What about digitalisation? How is the art scene? Furthermore, we will expand on elections, recent awareness on indigenous people, reflections on the period of white terror, and the media landscape.

We will have 60 minutes with Tobias Sauer and Antonia Märzhäuser - to discuss their insights and perception on the country being under constant threat from its big neighbour. Is there normality in daily life?

**Tobias Sauer** is a freelance reporter and editor based in Berlin. He contributes to German media outlets like Der Spiegel, Die Welt, and Geo. His passion in reporting goes to historical backgrounds of current developments, as well as on LGBT and human rights issues. Tobias

Sauer has reported from more than 20 countries on all continents. He holds a master degree in history, ethnology, politics and media science. **Antonia Märzhäuser** is a freelance Journalist from Berlin, who works for the German public radio and several national newspapers. Her writing focuses on EU-China-Taiwan relations and in recent years she has been covering the growing tensions over Taiwan and its implications for foreign policy frameworks in Germany and the EU. In 2019 she covered the pre-election period in Taiwan. She received an MA in Media Studies from the University of the Arts in Berlin and has lived in Japan where she wrote her Master Thesis on Tokyo's urban geography.
