## Video Guidelines

### TECHNICAL DETAILS

Please make sure to follow these guidelines when filming your application video:

- You don't necessarily need to use a camera to record your video, a smart phone works just fine.
- Please record the video in landscape/horizontal format (16:9 – rectangular, no square frames).
- Choose a well-lit setting, no backlight please.
- Find a quiet spot for the recording. Avoid loud and distracting background noise.
- File formats: mp4, mov, avi, mpeg
- Length: approx. three minutes

Please make sure to cover the following information in your video:

- Your name, country of origin, current residence (if you participated in an IJP programme before, please also include the year and title of your programme)

  - Why should we care about science communication?
  - Why would you like to be part of ComLab?
  - What do you hope to achieve in ComLab#6?
  - What can you contribute to ComLab#6?
