IJP – International Journalists' Programmes Energy & Climate Grant for Alumni in 2019

IJP – International Journalists' Programmes invites alumni from Croatia, the Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Slovenia, Slovakia and Germany to apply for a research grant focusing on climate and energy issues.

Successful candidates will receive a lump sum of **€2,500** for related travel, housing, insurance and living expenses in order to research one or several topics more in depth in one of the countries listed above.

The fellowship allows to travel to Germany or respectively to Croatia, the Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Slovenia, Slovakia. Similar to the regular IJP scholarships, the target country is Germany for those from outside Germany while journalists from German media outlets can travel to one of the other countries for a period of time that suits their research task (usually 2-4 weeks) starting in 2019. It is expected that the eligible candidates work independently.

Application documents should include:

- Cover letter addressing the current position and development of the applicant's career since attending the fellowship programme, if applicable with a current CV attached
- A detailed outline of the research project the candidate wants to pursue (500 words minimum)

Applications are judged on individual basis. There is no formal deadline, all applications will be judged on a first come, first served basis until funds are exhausted.
